## Frank Gehry Unveils New Design for Milstein Hall

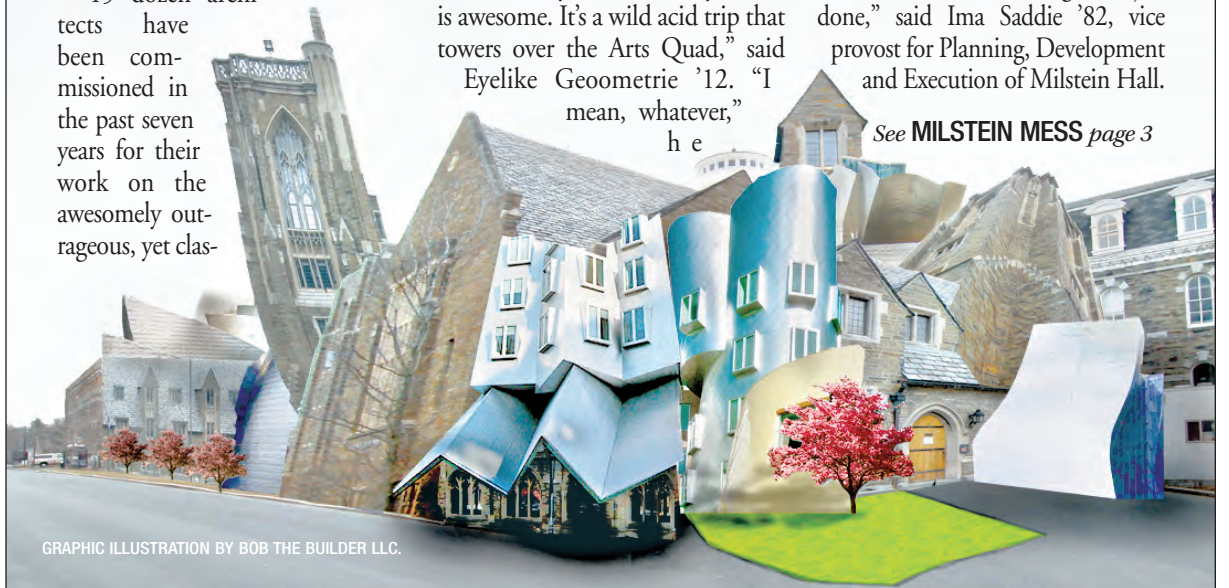

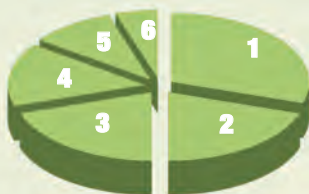
"F\*ck Harvard. F\*ck Yale. To Cornell we all should hail."

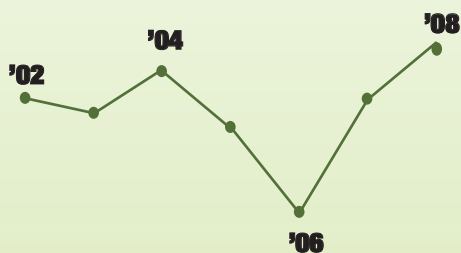
