## US Marshals, Police Arrest Georgia Fugitive in Ithaca

**ITHACA, N.Y.** – Members of the U.S. Marshals New York/New Jersey Regional Fugitive Task Force, Ithaca Police Department, New York State Police, Tompkins County Sheriff's and the Cayuga Heights Police Department Sept. 3 arrested a man wanted for murder in Georgia.

Adrian Dove, 48, was wanted by the Savannah Police Department for party to the crime of murder in which the victim was shot.

Investigators learned that Dove was a truck driver and that he had travelled to the Syracuse area. Further investigation revealed Dove was in Ithaca where the task force, working with federal, state and local law enforcement partners, was able to locate and arrest him without incident.

Dove was arraigned in Ithaca City Court as a fugitive from justice and will await further extradition proceedings.

"We are proud to have secured Mr. Dove's capture and wish to thank both the community and all of our fellow law enforcement agencies whose cooperation was so very important in this case," said David McNulty, the U.S. Marshal for the Northern District of New York.
